

## **ALICE General Questions and Answers Updated 7/19/2016**

**Q16:** Will there be a requirement for contractor provided vehicles?

**A16:** No; however the contracting officer may authorize a cost-reimbursement contractor to obtain interagency fleet management system (IFMS) vehicles and related services. Please see Clause H.19 within the Draft Request for Proposals (“RFP”).

**Q17:** Can you provide projected annual flight hours per aircraft type?

**A17:** The Government has determined that flight hours are not a primary factor in the establishment of staffing levels; therefore projected annual flight hours will not be provided.

**Q18:** Can you provide the solicitation evaluation criteria?

**A18:** This information is provided in Sections L & M of the Draft RFP, which was posted on July, 5, 2016.

**Q19:** Will the RFP include fixed fee and an award fee structure?

**A19:** Yes, the Draft RFP includes a fixed fee and an award fee structure, and if issued, the Government anticipates that the RFP will include a fixed fee and an award fee structure.

**Q20:** If there will be an award fee, can you define the requirement for earning award fee?

**A20:** This information will be provided in the near future. Please continue to monitor the ALICE website for updates.

**Q21:** In reference to paragraph 4.4.2 in the Draft SOW entitled “Personal Attire and Appearance”. Can you clarify the attire requirement for office personnel?

**A21:** Personnel shall wear attire appropriate to the work being performed.

**Q22:** Can you provide the technical library data bidders will need to determine staffing levels?

**A22:** If issued, the RFP, along with the technical library, will contain the information necessary to determine staffing levels.

**Q23:** Can you elaborate on time and place of pre-proposal conference?
